LOCKER ROOM CONDUCT & POLICY



What is it?

- USA Hockey requires that all local programs publish their locker room policy
- The policy includes the program's (1) supervision and monitoring of locker rooms, (2) addresses parents to be in or excluded from locker rooms (3) definition of prohibited conduct, and (4) use of mobile and recording devices
- Locker room conduct is a fundamental tenant of USA Hockey Safesport



Who is Responsible?

- Parents and players are responsible for reading, understanding, and following the SCIR Locker Room Policy.
- Coaches and Team Managers need to ensure proper Locker Room Supervision is present for all games and practices
- Locker room attendants are required to complete all SCIR compliance and included on the official USA Hockey roster
