## What is it?

- PAHL Fair Play Program (FPP) is designed to hold players and coaches accountable for their actions and behaviors
- The FPP points system rewards teams in PAHL standings
- Research and data has shown that the FPP system increases sportsmanship, accountability, and player safety without compromising competition.



## How is it calculated?

- A team may not earn a FPP point if a coach is assessed a game misconduct or match penalty
- A team may not earn a FPP point if the team reaches a penalty threshold in a game (12 or 16)
- A team may LOSE a point if they exceeds 24 or 32 penalty minutes in a game
- Possible FPP Points in a single game are 1, 0, or -1 and are included in standings
