CLOSER LOOK: LOCKER ROOM MONITORING



What is it?

- USA Hockey requires an adult locker room monitor during all team activities (practices and games)
- Locker Room monitors must complete all background and training requirements and listed on the official USA Hockey roster
- All adults serving as locker room monitors should be gender correct and the co-ed locker room policy must be followed



What else?

- It is the responsible of the coaching staff (Head Coach) to ensure locker room monitoring is provided for practices and games
- It may be necessary for coaches to trade off getting dressed, preparing the ice for practice, and monitoring the locker room to ensure proper supervision
- Only adults with proper training and clearances can fulfil the duties of a locker room monitor
